Application Requirement and Process	REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION 1. Passport photo – Please ensure the background is white, no shadow, with darker shirt, recommended photographs without spectacles & accessories, neutral expression with mouth closed, 35mm x 45mm, jpg file. 2. Passport copy – To scan all pages, (2 pages per page) all pages should be visible especially biodata page & validity should be more than 18 months. 3. Complete Health Declaration Form - To ensure (✓) in the column provided and the date written according to the format DD/MM/YYYY. 4. INTI International Student Application Form - To ensure Embassy/Single-Entry Visa (SEV) location is written in the form. 5. Confirmation Letter from partner university - To ensure the student's name & passport number is correct.
